



Cotswold Hilly 100 Relay Race

Route Directions – Leg 2



DANGER - all legs follow **NARROW LANES/MAIN ROADS**

PARKING – do not block the road or cover the changeover points

Please be considerate to other traffic and users of the countryside.

ABBREVIATIONS TL – turn left TR – turn right SO – straight on

Directions to Start of Leg 2 (end of Leg 1)

From Long Marston, take road towards Mickleton. Soon after road goes over humped back bridge over railway line, TR (signposted Pebworth). At next junction, TL (signposted Mickleton). Look for telegraph poles on right hand side.

SO to MICKLETON (over a mile) and go past BUTCHERS ARMS pub on left		1.56
Up to junction with Main Road B4632 (Costcutters store facing opposite)		1.69
TR (signposted CHELTENHAM) and pass KINGS ARMS pub on left		1.85
Leave village. Bear left at mini-roundabout (signposted Chipping Campden B4035)		2.04
Start to climb and pass under bridge		2.91
Long climb passing turning on left for the ‘Hidcotes’ and ‘Kiftsgate’		3.72
Short incline down to T-junction. TL (signposted CHIPPING CAMPDEN B4035)		3.95
SO through market town passing the old Market Hall on right		4.85
Immediately after RED LION , TL into SHEEP STREET (sign to Moreton-in-Marsh)		4.98
Public toilets on left just after turning and follow road as it bends to right		5.21
Leave Chipping Campden up steep hill and SO to crossroads with Main Road A44		7.46
SO across Main Road (sign to Ford/Stanway). Continue over small crossroads.		8.91
TR at next junction (signposted SNOWHILL village only)		9.16
SO between houses and Lavendar Farm		
TR at crossroads (signposted SNOWHILL/BROADWAY)		9.74
After crossroads, look for barn with tin roof in field on left		
<u>END</u> Near BARN
